José Manuel Estévez-Saá's academic trajectory has been recognised with four six-year research periods / **4 sexenios de investigación** (24 uninterrupted years of international-quality research: 1998-2003, 2004-2009, 2010-2016, and 2017-2022) by the *Comisión Nacional Evaluadora de la Actividad Investigadora* (CNEAI).

He has published widely in national and international academic journals, such as *Contemporary Literature*, *Nordic Irish Studies*, *Anglo-Saxonica*, *Papers on Joyce*, *University of Bucharest Review: A Journal of Literary and Cultural Studies*, *Océánide*, *Philologia Hispalensis*, *SARE: Southeast Asian Review of English*, *Philologica Canariensis*, *Ventana Abierta: Revista Latina de Literatura, Arte y Cultura* or *Hispanorama*, all of them indexed in specialised databases. His book chapters have been published in national and international academic publishing houses (Peter Lang, WVT Wissenschaftlicher Verlag Trier, Cosmos, Minerva, Netbiblo, Arcibel, Biblioteca Nueva, Cambridge Scholars Publishing, Escibana Books), always after the preceptive double peer review process. Most of his articles and chapters have been positively reviewed in academic journals such as *Atlantis*, *Estudios Irlandeses*, *Papers on Joyce*, *James Joyce Quarterly*, *James Joyce Literary Supplement*, or *Irish University Review*.

Estévez Saá has already supervised six PhD Dissertations in three different universities (Universidad de Sevilla, 2008; Universidade da Coruña, 2012, 2014, 2018, and 2023),

Universidade de Santiago de Compostela, 2016), all of them obtaining the highest grade. He is currently supervising five additional doctoral dissertations.

José Manuel Estévez-Saá, Senior Lecturer at the Universidade da Coruña (**Profesor Titular de Universidad desde el 09/12/2008, acreditado a Catedrático de Universidad desde el 17/10/2024**), has coordinated the PhD Programme *Nuevas Aproximaciones a los Estudios anglonorteamericanos e Irlandeses*, and is currently the coordinator at UDC of the Máster Interuniversitario en *Estudios Ingleses Avanzados y sus Aplicaciones*.

Estévez Saá has published more than 200 academic studies, and he has been invited to deliver over twenty plenary conferences at national and international academic institutions. He holds a Master's degree in *Exclusión Social, Integración y Ciudadanía*, a Master's degree in *Relaciones Internacionales*, the title of *Experto Universitario en Inmigración, Exclusión y Políticas de Integración Social*; and has already presented and published numerous theoretical studies on the subject of late-twentieth-century and early-twenty-first-century migrations, such as "La política económica de progreso como causa de un neo-racismo sociocultural. Una aproximación antropológico-literaria" (2003), "The Experience of Estrangement" (2005), "Interculturalidad y Globalización con sus retos y discursos narrativos: ¿principio o fin?" (2007), "La cultura de la frontera y los movimientos migratorios en Estados Unidos y la Unión Europea" (2016), "Emigración, exilio e identidad" (2017), in addition to the publication of articles in the cultural supplement of the newspaper *El Correo Gallego*, such as "La mirada inmigrante. Un fenómeno que requiere un diagnóstico social y afectivo" (2011) and "Experiencias del exilio. Del desarraigo interior al grito de esperanza y libertad" (2011).

Estévez-Saá's studies about the topic of migrations began with the study of writers John Berger and Doris Lessing, who represented in their works the migratory waves and post-migration settlements that were taking place in Europe during the twentieth century; and published works such as "*The Sweetest Dream* de Doris Lessing como ejemplo de denuncia y del nuevo debate Norte-Sur" (2006), "El significado de la tierra en la Literatura Campesina en lengua inglesa: John Berger" (2007), "Una reivindicación de la mujer en sus (con)textos anglosajones, multiétnicos, eurocéntricos y gallegos" (2007), "From the Country to de City: the Peasant's Loss of Identity in John Berger's Trilogy" (2007). More recently, he has presented and published studies on authors such as Mary O'Donnell, Edna O'Brien, Tabish Khair, Mohsin Hamid and Tariq Mehmood, whose works he has analysed from a transculturalist perspective. Estévez Saá has been the main researcher of the projects *The Great Irish Famine and its Age-Old Silence in Europe. A Literary-Anthropological and Socio-Political Approach through its Cultural (Con)Texts* (Ref. FFI2009-12751), *New Typologies of European (E/Im)Migration and Their Representation in Twenty-First-Century Literature in English* (Ref. FFI2012-38790), and *Estética, ética y estrategias de las nuevas cartografías migratorias e identidades transculturales en las literaturas en lengua inglesa del siglo XXI (2007-2019)* (Ref. PID2019-1095826BI00).

Estévez Saá has carried out research stays in different universities such as University College London; Oxford University; Stendhal University (Grenoble III); University of Limerick; Goldsmiths, University London; and Trinity College Dublin; and he has been Invited Visiting Professor at the University de California (UCSB), and at the City University of New York (CUNY-CCNY).
