Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 5000 characters, including spaces)

I have a broad background in antimicrobial resistance, bacterial virulence and treatments, with specific training and expertise in molecular and cellular biology and in animal models of infection. During my doctoral studies, I investigated patterns of hemoglobin-based oxygen carrier (HBOC) side effects, and the interaction between HBOC and vascular reactivity mechanisms. As postdoc my research centered on the pathogenicity of Gram-negative bacilli (GNB), especially the study of cellular and molecular mechanisms involved in their interaction with host cell. I have also developed new projects resulting in the identification of new virulence factors of GNB, and the development of inhibitors that block these virulence factors, as a non-antimicrobial approach for multidrug-resistant bacteria therapy. In 2016 and 2021 I got Miguel Servet tipo I (MSI) and tipo II (MSII) grants (ISCIII) in the Institute of Biomedicine of Seville (IBiS) where I develop my research lines focused in the bacterial pathogenesis, new antimicrobial resistance mechanisms and antimicrobial and repurposing drugs treatment. Since 2022 I got a **Professor** position in the UPO and PI in the CABD where I continue with the development of my research lines. My research has been always interdisciplinary (infectious diseases, microbiology, molecular and cellular biology), and highly collaborative. My research activity thus far has resulted in successful funding of grants and projects, and the establishment of a network of collaborators worldwide. I have produced **76 publications**, 55 as first or last and/or corresponding author. My International experience is remarkable including **two post-doctoral stays**: one year at Nancy University (France), and 8 years postdoc at IBiS (Spain). In terms of Research projects, I have participated so far in **32 research projects** (EU OPENSURE, COST ACTION, FP7, JPIAMR, CYTED, ISCIII, AEI, Junta de Andalucía, UPO). I have been **PI in 18 research projects**, 5 internationals and 13 nationals. Since I started my research career in 2003, I have competed successfully and being awarded by several regional and national research societies and governmental entities (SAEI, SEIMC,

ISCI). I got a REIPI postdoctoral Fellowship (ISCI), as well as **MS I** and **MS II**. I am **member of the evaluation panel** of international (eCOST, EUREKA, EUROSTART, INNOWIDE, Innovation Fund Denmark, JPIAMR, UK Research & Innovation, ESCMID, Poland National Science Centre), national (ANEP, Cidi-Salud, European Quality Assurance, Fundación Profesor Nova Santos) and regional (Comunidad de Madrid, Junta de Andalucía) agencies. I am **Associate Editor** in Front. Pharmacol. and **Guest-Editor** in 7 different Research Topics and Special Issues in Front. Pharmacol., Front. Microbiol. and Antibiotics, and **Referee** for more than 200 articles in 48 different journals. In addition, I have reviewed different international communications (11th Int. Symp. of the Biology of *Acinetobacter* “ISBA”; ESCMID Conference on Coronavirus Disease 2020, 31st and 32nd ECCMID). In terms of **communicating research**, my contributions include 23 invited talks and >100 oral communications and posters in national and international congress. In terms of **organization and management**, I am the Director of the Cellular Biology and Biotechnology Department of the CABD (since 2023). I am member of the “Junta de Centro” of the CABD (since 2022). I have been member of **IBiS Scientific Board** (2017-22), member of **Spanish Network in Infectious Diseases** (2007-21), **CIBER of Infectious Diseases** (2022) and **PAI group** (Plan Andaluz de Investigación, since 2007), member of Ethical Commission for Experimentation with Genetically Modified Organisms and Biological Agents in Pablo de Olavide University (2021-24), member of the **Organized Committee** of the 11th ISBA (Seville, 2017) and the 3rd meeting of the CA21145 (Seville, 2025), **moderator in Scientific Congress** (27th ECCMID, Vienna 2017; XVI Foro de Investigadores of IBiS, Seville 2020), **scientific manager** of the IBiS Hypoxia Chamber Facility (2015-22), **coordinator of the seminars** of the IBiS Infectious Diseases Area (2018-22), **national ambassador** of the Reviewer Credits (Since 2018). In 2024, I have been nominated by the Vice-Rector for Research, Transfer and Doctorate of the UPO, as **candidate for membership of the Group of Chief Scientific Advisors to the European Commission**. In mentoring, I am supervising **3 PhD students** and I have supervised **6 PhD theses** (2017-24). One of them have obtained the “**Premio Extraordinario de Doctorado**” from Seville University (2019). Currently, these 6 PhDs are continuing their research carriers as postdoc in BioTech (Norten Biotechnology, LeitTAT Managing Technology) and in Academia (*Institut Hospital del Mar d’Investigacions Mèdiques*, Hospital Virgen del Rocío of Seville). In addition, I have directed 18 MSc theses, and 10 undergraduate Projects. Finally, I have registered **4 Patents**, and **co-founded a Spin-off** for antibacterial compounds development.
