Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 5000 characters, including spaces)

My research career over the last 20 years has focused on the study of early medieval landscapes, with special attention to Northwest Iberia, from an interdisciplinary approach that combines archaeological and textual records. In 2008 I obtained a PhD in Medieval History at the University of Santiago (supervised by Prof. Andrade-Cernadas) with a thesis on the territorial organization of Galicia between the Antiquity and Central Middle Ages, based on the integration of material, written and toponymy sources using GIS and spatial analysis. In the following years I mainly worked on rural churches and monasteries and their social and political meanings in Early Medieval landscapes, but I have also paid increasing attention in the last years to fortifications, funerary sites and agrarian landscapes, as well as their heritage values

in present day society. One of the main scientific and social impacts of my research is the explanation of the origins and evolution of the traditional rural landscapes that are currently in process of radical transformation or abandonment in NW Spain.

My educational background, both as a historian of texts and archaeologist, included long formative periods in international leading centers: first at the University of Siena (Italy), in which I completed a Master in Medieval Archaeology granted by the Barrié de la Maza Foundation in 2004, with the leading group of R. Francovich, then as a predoctoral fellow at the CSIC-Spanish School of History and Archaeology at Rome (Italy) for 2 years (2005-06), then at the CSIC Laboratory of Landscape Archaeology with Prof. F. Criado (2007), Casa de Velázquez (Madrid, October-December 2008), and finally as a postdoctoral researcher at the Institute of Archaeology of the University College of London for 5 years (first as Spanish Ministry of Science fellowship, later as Honorary Research Associate and finally as a postdoc fellow of the Galician Regional Government) under the supervision of Prof. Andrew Reynolds.

In 2013 I obtained a Marie Curie-CIG grant, funded with 100.000 euros in order to carry out the project "Early Medieval Churches: History, Archaeology and Heritage", and in 2015 I was awarded with a "Ramón y Cajal" tenure track position which allowed me to join the area of Archaeology of the University of Santiago. After passing the I3 national evaluation in 2019, I became "Profesor Contratado Doctor" in 2021 and "Profesor Titular" in 2022. I currently have 3 research "sexenios" recognized by the ANECA.

In the last 12 years I have obtained roughly 611.000 euros of research funding from regional, national and European bodies which allowed me to create an informal research group on early medieval history and archaeology (12 research associates contracted for a total of 7 years, and 6 PhD students). I have been the PI of 4 research projects on medieval landscapes, churches and monasteries: EMCHAHE (funded by the EU), TERPOMED (funded by Galician Government), ARPAMED and ECOLOC (funded by the Spanish Ministry of Science). These projects include international collaborations, mainly with Newcastle and Siena Universities. In 2020. I have been finalist 4 times of the ERC Grant calls, being rated as "A" and "B". I have also been the PI of 7 contracts with administrations for a total of 70000 €.

I am the author of 96 scientific publications, many of them in leading journals like *Antiquity*, *Medieval Archaeology*, *Archaeological and Anthropological Sciences*, *Environmental Archaeology*, *Anuario de Estudios Medievales*, *Hortus Artium Medievalium*, *Antiquité Tardive*, *Archivo Español de Arqueología*, *Hispania*, *Zephyrus*, *Studia Histórica*, *Historia Medieval*, *Archaeological and Anthropological Sciences*, *Melanges de la Casa de Velázquez*, *Quintana*, *Arqueología de la Arquitectura* or *Reti Medieval*, being the first author in most of them.

I have participated in more than 70 scientific meetings (being invited to more than 30 of them) in Spain, Italy, Ireland, Germany, Portugal, Turkey, UK and France, and I have organized 15 scientific meetings, including organized sessions at the EEA Annual Meeting and the International Medieval Congress Leeds.

I have promoted or collaborated in 21 archaeological fieldwork campaigns in Spain and Italy, and I have been Scientific Director of 14 of them, as the recent excavations at Budiño, Combarro, Rente, Cidadela, San Mamede and Portomeiro sites.

I have been the supervisor of 3 PhD thesis: Mario Fernández Pereiro, on early medieval fortifications in Galicia (2019), Laura Blanco Torrejón on early medieval funerary sites (2022) and Celtia Rodríguez González, on gender archaeology in Late Antique NW Iberia (2022), and I am currently the supervisor of other 4 ongoing PhD thesis. I have also been the supervisor of 13 Master dissertations (TFM) in the last 10 years.

I have been a referee of near 50 publications and evaluator of 15 research projects for Spanish, Croatian, Swiss, Italian and Icelandic research bodies as well as a potential World Heritage site for ICOMOS.
