Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 5000 characters, including spaces)

Bárbara Boloix Gallardo has a PhD in Arabic Philology from the University of Granada (2007), having obtained the European Doctorate Mention by the University of London (UK). She is currently a Senior Lecturer of Arabic and Islamic Studies at the Department of Semitic Studies of the University of Granada. Her main area of study is the History of al-Andalus and the Maghreb, especially that of the Nasrid kingdom of Granada (13th-15th centuries). In the last decade she has dedicated most of her scientific production to the study of both Nasrid and Maghribi women in the Middle Ages. She has conducted several predoctoral research periods financed by public institutions at Al Manar University of Tunisia (2003), University of Cairo (2004) and University of London (2007). She has also completed postdoctoral research periods at the University of Puerto Rico (2008-2009) and Washington University in Saint Louis, Missouri, US (2011-2013). She is currently a member of the Research Group “Ciudades Andaluzas Bajo el Islam” (HUM-150) since 2002, the University of Granada’s Research Institute for Women's and Gender Studies, since 2021, and the Technical Committee of the Alhambra, from 2023. She has been the main researcher of 5 research projects, among which are the I+D+i “Nasrid and Marinid women in the Islamic societies of the Medieval Mediterranean (13th-15th centuries): Power, Identity and Social Dynamics -NAZAMER-” (HAR2017-88117-P) and “From Nasrid to Morisco Women: Daily lives, Influences and Socio-cultural (dis)continuities in the “Intrahistory” of the Peninsular Context (13th-15th centuries)” (PID2021-128770OB-I00), both financed by the Spanish of Science and Innovation. She has participated in 7 research projects and 3 scientific units: the Academic Unit of Excellence “Science at the Alhambra” (University of Granada-Board of Trustees of the Alhambra and the Generalife; 2018-2022), the Associated Unit I+D+i (University of Granada and the Spanish National Research Council) “Arab and Islamic Cultural Heritage”, which she had also coordinated (2020-2023), and the “Excellence Unit of Feminist and Gender Studies” from the UGR. She is the sole author of 15 SCOPUS scientific articles, 5 articles in indexed journals, 10 popular science articles, sole author of 4 books (1) and editor of another 4 and 5 journal dossiers, 45 book

chapters in prestigious editing houses, and 20 encyclopedia entries. She has participated in 48 international conferences and seminars, and delivered 30 lectures. She has 3 recognized six-year research periods (sexenios). To these merits it should be added other teaching activities, such as her participation in both 13 seminars and in 2 teaching innovation projects based at the University of Granada and the University of Malaga (2019-2021). Since 2017, she is a professor of the University Master's Degree in Arabic and Hebrew Cultures: Al-Andalus and Contemporary Arab World (UGR), in which she has supervised 10 TFM's (mainly on History of al-Andalus and the Maghreb) with high qualifications and directs several Doctoral Dissertations. She is currently Vice-secretary for Cultural and Institutional Cooperation at the Euro-Arab Foundation in Granada. In 2024 she obtained the accreditation for the academic figure of Full professor (Catedrática de Universidad) from the ANECA.
